**ideal time - Competitions with a time norm, which is called "ideal time". Penalty points for failure to achieve the "ideal time" are not awarded. If the "ideal time" is exceeded, then one penalty point is awarded for each four seconds that have begun. Other errors are evaluated according to table A. The best result will have the athlete whose result – penalty points, the difference between the made time and the "ideal time" – is the smallest. If penalty points and the difference are the same, the best result is for a participant who has not exceeded the ideal time. Other athletes are ranked by penalty points and the time difference between the made time and the "ideal time".*

****Team competition, 2.stage:** competition with one round according to Art.238.2.1. Team consists of 3 riders, each of them will be jumping different height – first rider 90cm, second rider 100cm and the third rider – 110cm. Team result will be calculated by counting the penalty points and time of each rider.

Youth Cup:

Children – up to 14 years old;

Juniors – from 14 to 18 years old;

U25 – from 16 to 25 years old.

Children, juniors and U25 riders can participate with several horses. Rider will receive points with the horse, that is entered first in the class. Riders are allowed to take part in open classes. Horse can have no more than two starts per day.

In each class riders will receive points according to the table below. In case of equivalent points, winner will be decided by the result of the last day.

Award ceremony

The number of athletes required to present themselves for the prize-giving ceremony of each competition is 6. The participants should appear at the award ceremony with ponies/horses. In special cases, the Chief Jury, in consultation with the Organising Committee, may authorize a participant to appear at the award ceremony without a horse.

If less than 12 riders take part in a class, prize fund will be decreased to 70% of the planned prize money (including children, junior and U25 classes).

If less than 5 riders take part in a class, it will be cancelled (not applicable to the children, junior and U25 classes).

Prize money will be transferred to the winners bank account!

Applications

Applications should be submitted **by 20:00, Wednesday, June 28**, by filling in an application form via Equipe Entry system entry.equipe.com. Make sure you fill out all required fields and submit rider and horse names. If your application is accepted, you will get notification e-mail from Equipe system.

When applying for participation in open classes up to and including 100 cm, please note whether the rider starts with a horse or a pony.

Organiser can close application form before time, according to capacity of competition venue. If applications are submitted after 20:00, June 29, entry fee will be doubled.

The participants take personal responsibility for possible incidents during the competitions. Participants up to 16 years old must have protective vests. The ARS Emergency Medical Service and a veterinarian will be on duty during the competition.

Competitors must comply with the LEF Latvia veterinary requirements (<http://www.leflatvia.lv/web/?id=419196>). Valid horse passports must be presented with all necessary veterinary records and vaccinations of horses (INAN examinations and vaccination of equine influenza), passports will be checked! If a horse passport is not presented, or any mandatory vaccination is missing, the horse will not be admitted to the competition, and the entry fee will not be refunded!

Any situations that have not been mentioned in the Rules will be resolved by the Judges and the Organiser.

By participating in the competition, you agree that the event will be filmed and photographed. The images resulting from the photography/video filming may be broadcast, published and distributed.
